Kings, Queens, & Princesses Printable Crowns

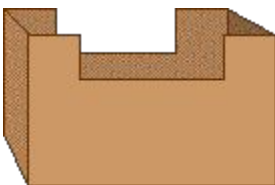
Materials

1. Heavy duty scissors or craft knife
2. Box
3. String
4. Tape or glue
5. Crayons, paint, or markers

Instructions

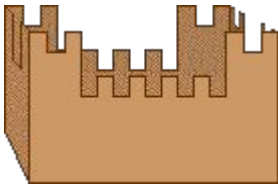


1. Find a box and cut off the top flaps. Any type of box will do: a large cardboard box makes a large castle, a shoebox makes a fine, small castle. To cut thick cardboard, try a craft knife.

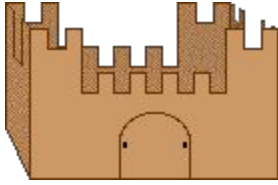


2. Cut out a wide rectangle along the front front, sides, and the back to form towers at the corners.

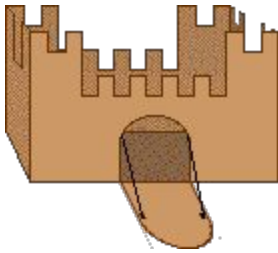




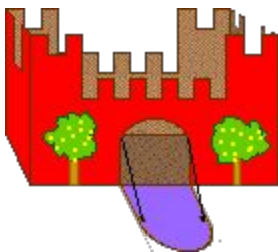
3. Cut out rectangles along the entire top of the castle.



4. Draw a drawbridge at the front of the castle. Using the point of a scissors, poke 2 small holes in the sides of the drawbridge and on both sides of the wall next to it. Cut out the drawbridge.



5. Attach a string to each side of the drawbridge and the adjoining wall.



6. Decorate the castle with paint, markers, or crayons.
