

Dragons Hatching Dragon Egg Experiment

Materials

- 1. Baking soda
- 2. Vinegar or lemon juice
- 3. Water
- 4. Food Coloring (optional)
- 5. Small plastic dragons or other figures
- 6. Plastic wrap
- 7. Squirt bottle or eyedropper
- 8. Mixing bowls

Instructions

- 1. Add baking soda and a small amount of water to a mixing bowl. The mixture becomes crumbly and packable not runny.
- 2. Divide the contents into different bowls and add food coloring to each bowl (optional).
- 3. Pack the mixture around your plastic figure to form an egg and use plastic wrap to help keep the shape.





- 4. Place the colorful dragon eggs in the freezer for as long as you like. The more frozen the eggs are, the longer they will take to melt.
- 5. Once frozen, place the dinosaur eggs on a dish. Squirt the eggs with vinegar or lemon, watch them fizz and hatch!
