Dragons

Hatching Dragon Egg Experiment

Materials

1. Baking soda
2. Vinegar or lemon juice
3. Water
4. Food Coloring (optional)
5. Small plastic dragons or other figures
6. Plastic wrap
7. Squirt bottle or eyedropper
8. Mixing bowls

Instructions

1. Add baking soda and a small amount of water to a mixing bowl. The mixture becomes crumbly and packable not runny.
2. Divide the contents into different bowls and add food coloring to each bowl (optional).
3. Pack the mixture around your plastic figure to form an egg and use plastic wrap to help keep the shape.



4. Place the colorful dragon eggs in the freezer for as long as you like. The more frozen the eggs are, the longer they will take to melt.
5. Once frozen, place the dinosaur eggs on a dish. Squirt the eggs with vinegar or lemon, watch them fizz and hatch!
