

Kings and Queens Ice Castle Excavation

Materials:

- 1. Castle or any shape sand bucket
- 2. Jewels, beaded necklaces, crowns, rings, etc.
- 3. Water
- 4. Salt
- 5. Dropper
- 6. Popsicle stick

Instructions:

- 1. Grab a few princess items and place them in your sand bucket. Add a little bit of water and put in the freezer until almost frozen.
- 2. Take it out and add more things and more water and freeze.
- 3. Continue to do the same thing until the bucket is full of ice and jewels.
- 4. To excavate, provide a bowl of salt, a dropper, popsicle stick, and water.
- 5. Ask, "How are we going to get those jewels out of the castle?" Provide the child with cold/lukewarm water first. Then encourage the use of hotter water.
- 6. Just add salt and water and chip away to collect those jewels.








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
