Wizards & Witches Paper Roll Wizards

Supplies Needed:

Toilet paper roll

Crafters tape/glue stick/glue gun

Scissors

Black marker

1 Small pink bead

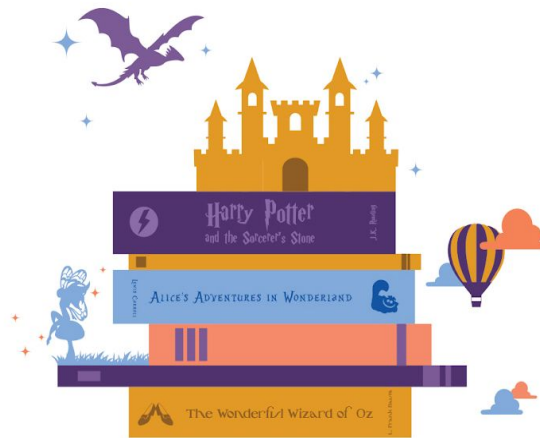
Gold star stickers

Wooden skewer

Instructions

1. Print out the attached template.
2. Cut out all of the pieces, glue the large blue rectangle onto the bottom edge of the paper roll.
3. You will need at least 1 inch of the paper roll showing above the blue paper so you can draw the wizard's face.
4. Make straight, evenly spaced cuts about two thirds of the way up your white rectangles to create a "fringe." My cuts were about $\frac{1}{4}$ inch apart.
5. Place a round marker along the bottom of the "fringe" then carefully roll the cut paper over the marker.

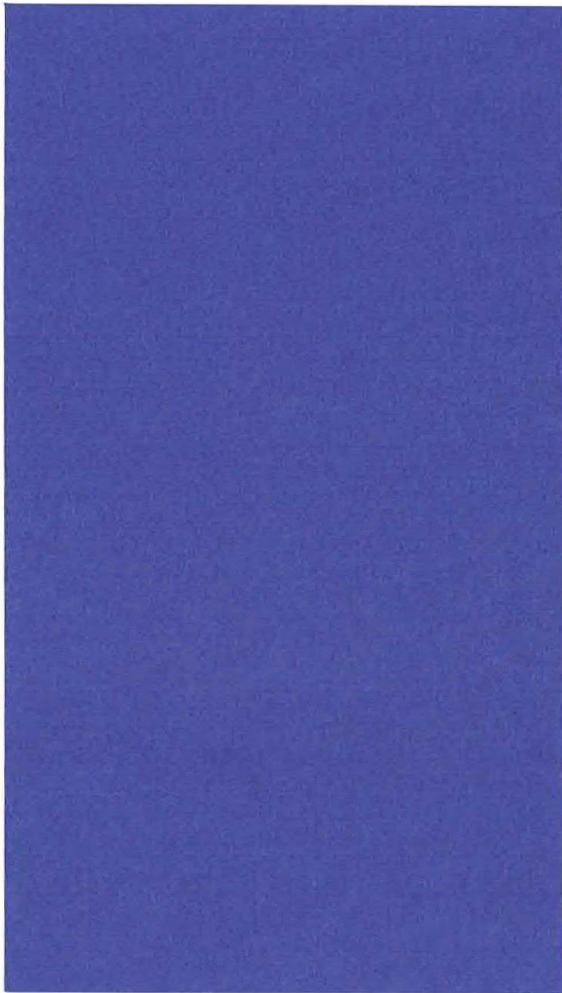

6. First draw two circles. Then draw a line outwards from the edge of the two circles. Next draw the part of the glasses that goes over the nose. And finally draw two circles inside each of the glasses to make your wizard's eyes.
7. Attach the beard slightly below the eyes that you drew, making sure the fringe curls outwards.
8. Glue on the mustache and attach the nose.
9. Attach the hair, making sure the fringe curls outwards.
10. Take the piece of paper that's shaped like a semi-circle and wrap it into a cone shape.
11. Attach the hat to the wizard's head.
12. Add the gold stars to the hat and cloak.
13. Draw a small mouth underneath the mustache.
14. Take the wooden skewer and cut it down to size (about 4 inches.)
15. Add the glittery stars to the top of the skewer.

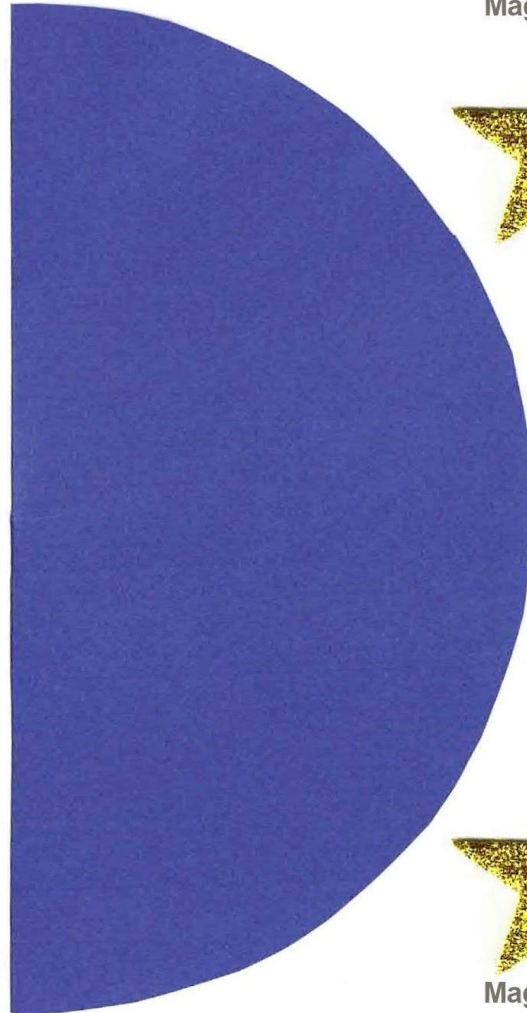


PAPER ROLL WIZARD TEMPLATE

Magic Wand

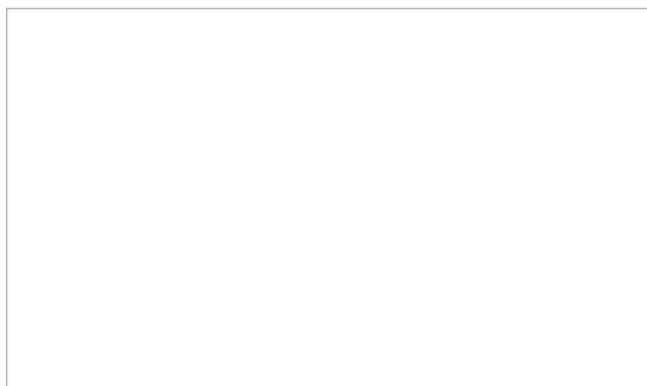


Mustache

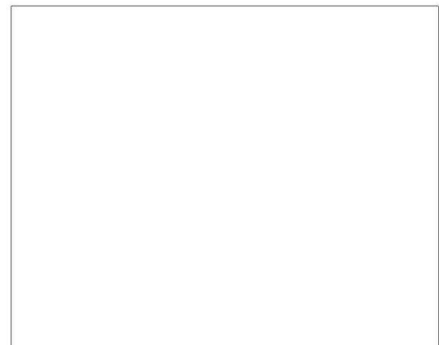


Magic Wand

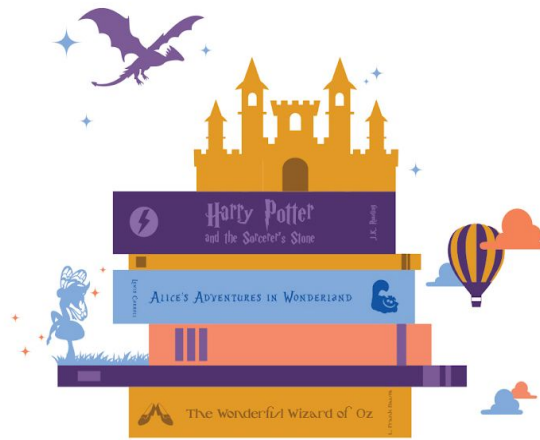
Wizard's Hair
