

## Fairies Shadow Chalk Art

June 24th is National Fairy Day!

Materials:

Sunny Day

Open Space

Recycled Chalk Paint (see recipe attached)

Sidewalk chalk Paintbrushes

#### Instructions:

- 1. Invite the children to lie down on the open space, block out the sunlight, and make a shadow on the ground.
- 2. Use sidewalk chalk to trace the shadows in various positions.
- 3. Use the recycled sidewalk paint or sidewalk chalk to "fill in" or color the shadow. What great fun!







# Shadow Chalk Art Recycled Chalk Paint

Materials: Broken and/or new pieces of sidewalk chalk

1 Qt Freezer Bags

Rubber Mallet or Hammer Recycled container for water

Water

Old muffin tin Paint Brushes

Chopstick

**Small Kitchen Towel** 

#### Instructions:

- 1. Sort the chalk by color.
- 2. Put each color of the sidewalk chalk into a separate freezer bag.
- 3. Wrap each bag of sidewalk chalk in a small kitchen towel and use the rubber mallet or hammer to gently crush the chalk into a fine powder.
- 4. Add the powdered chalk to the muffin tin. Put one color of chalk powder into each muffin tin.
- 5. Slowly pour water into the powder. Mix with the paintbrush or chopstick. The paint should be the consistency of pancake batter.

6. Give your homemade chalk paint 30-60 minutes to sit and settle. Give it a good stir before painting with it.
